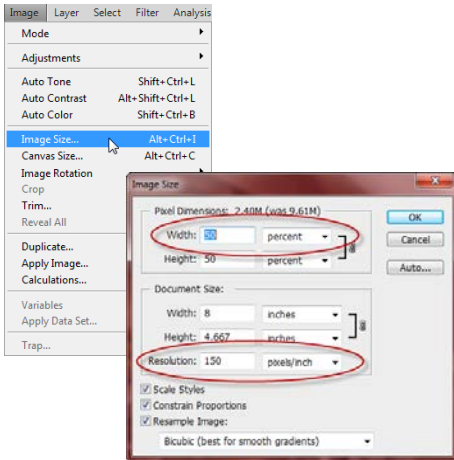




ONLINE MIDPOINT & FINAL REVIEW: **Graphic Resizing in Photoshop**

If your PowerPoint file is too large to send via email or load into the online review meeting room, please follow instructions below to resize JPEG images:

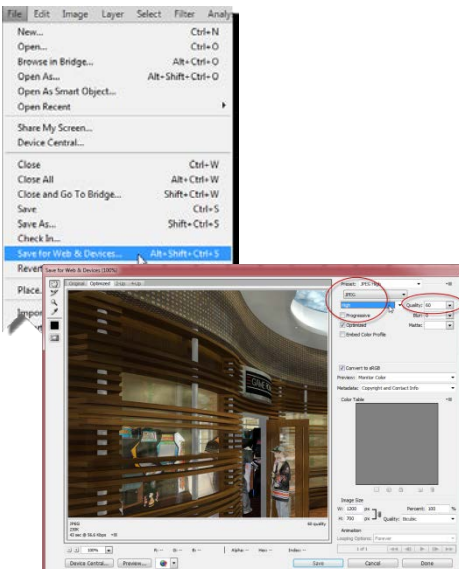
1. Open your picture in Photoshop



2. Go into **Image** → **Image Size** and change the drop down from pixels or inches to **percent**.

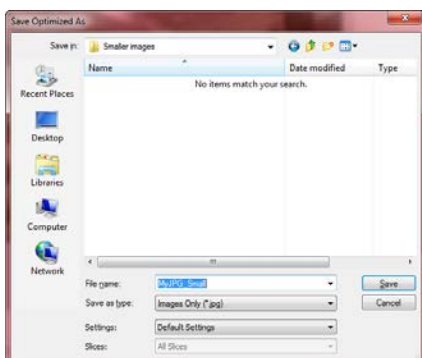
3. Change the **Width** to a smaller percent.

Try **50 percent** and the **Resolution** to **150 pixels** per inch and click **OK**.



4. Go into **File** → **Save for Web & Devices**

Select **JPEG** and change the **Quality** to be **High (60)** and **Save**.



5. Select **location** of JPEG and **rename** to preserve original file. I would suggest renaming the new file *OriginalFileName_sm.jpg* (example: FrontPanelExterior_sm.jpg)

6. Click the **Save** button
